





- 1. Area around towers was concrete.
- 2.Pool was exposed, surrounded by dirt.
- 3. Front of building was unappealing dirt bank.


- 1. Verander & micro gardens created around ground floor.
- 2.Pool privatised with trees & shrubbery, stone walkways to combat mud transfer.
 - 3.Bank transformed with grass & flowerbeds.

- Residents' wellness enhanced with air quality and aesthetic improvements.
- Pool area was transformed from undesirable and inconvenient into the centrepiece of the residency.
- Frontage of residency was transformed from wasteland to well-recognised feature despite not being in original scope.

Challenges

- 1. Area between towers was wasteland.
- 2.Pool was exposed, easily viewable from entrance.
 - 3.Continual disruptions from ongoing infrastructural development.
- 1.Piazza of Serenity created using large trees for shade.
- 2.Pool privatised with trees & shrubbery, including distinctive palms.
- 3.Ongoing maintenance contract allowed restoration when contruction destroyed original finishing.

- ❖ Residents' wellness enhanced with air quality and aesthetic improvements.
- Privacy and beauty created around pool area with fishtail and royal palms.
- Original scope was modified multiple times and so end result demonstrated flexibility to adapt to shrinking budget.
- Maintenance contract helped to mitigate damage to garden features caused by infrastructural building work.



Challenges


- 1. Whole Area was concrete and lived in for several years before landscape.
- 2.Individual swimming pools were visible from neighbouring buildings
 - 3.Patch at front of the building was overgrown with unattractive weeds.
- 1.Micro Gardens created at base of each apartment
- 2.Line of Weeping Willows creates curtain of privacy (naturally bunch together).
- 3. Front Garden transformed with a wide variety of flowering plants.

- Residents' wellness enhanced with air quality and aesthetic improvements.
- Original scope was modified multiple times and so end result demonstrated flexibility to modify to shrinking budget.
 - Front garden has become wellrecognised point of beauty on wellfrequented road.









Brief

Budget: \$50,000

Size: 3.5 Acres

Location Type: Coastal Resort

Project Working with new owners to revitalise and tranform from family holiday home to commercial resort.

Challenges

- 1.Entire site was overgrown and wild.
- 2.Ground was not suitable for desired planting.
- 3. Swimming Pool exposed to sea.

- 1. Tree surgeons brought in to bring trees back under control and improve aethetics.
- 2. Soil conditioners including Cocoapeat and organic compost revitalised soil.
- 3. Trees and shrubs designed to create micro-climate for pool area, protection from sea and evaporation.

- Now a premium waterfront destination.
- Landscaping improved existing features such as pool and created new ones, including seafront chalet and barbecue.
- Added value provided by micro-nursery to enable on site provision of flowers for events.
